NOTES:

- Buses **MUST** enter the school grounds by way of Glen Oak Dr. If you are approaching **from SPID**, continue to the last traffic light on Waldron Rd (Glen Oak Dr) and turn **LEFT** onto Glen Oak. If you are approaching from **Yorktown Rd**, turn **RIGHT** onto Glen Oak. From this point, take Glen Oak Dr and turn **LEFT** onto the school entrance between the Baseball Field and the Early Childhood Center. Follow this drive to the Auditorium and unload students at the sidewalk at the end of the Auditorium complex.
- Buses remaining at the Auditorium after unloading students can park either at the back of the parking lot by the Auditorium, or park at the baseball parking lot adjacent to the Auditorium.
- Buses are to **EXIT** the Auditorium by continuing along the drive and exit onto Waldron Rd.
- **OFFICE** for Con/SR will be the first room inside the entrance at the corner of the Auditorium building.
- **Bring Form 1** (list of eligible students) **signed** by campus principal the day of contest
- Bring three sets of **COPYRIGHT COMPLIANT** scores (with **ALL** measures numbered) for judges
- Bring three copies of seating charts to assist with set-up
- Warm-up is in the High School Choir, which is a very small room. The chairs and stands will **NOT** be in your normal concert set up, and there is not enough space for music stands for all students. You may rearrange the available chairs and stands anyway you like, but it will be part of your warm-up time.
- Warm-up time includes entering, warm-up, and exiting the room. The warm-up room must be **VACANT** at the designated ending time.
- Concert performance is in the High School Auditorium
- **Movement time to stage (10 minutes) includes set-up and any additional warm-up or tuning. Concert performance is expected to begin at designated time.**
- Sight Reading is in the High School Band Hall immediately following the concert performance.
- Results will be available for pick up in the office approximately 5 minutes after Sight-Reading is completed.
