Subject: Concert & Sight-Reading Evaluation Instructions

Please carefully review these Site Instructions and all additional information to assist you at the UIL Region XIV Band Evaluation at Sinton High School in Sinton, TX, on April 19-21, 2022. Please share this information with other staff members, administrators, transportation, parents, students and others as appropriate.

1. Contest Office is in the corridor in front of the Auditorium. Directors should report to the Contest Office when they arrive and turn in their **Form 1 (List of Eligible Students) SIGNED BY THE CAMPUS PRINCIPAL**, three copies of their **SEATING CHART**, and three sets of scores (**Copyright Compliant**) for the judges with **ALL MEASURES NUMBERED**.
2. Arrive at Sinton HS 30 minutes prior to warm-up time to allow time to unload students and equipment and to line up to enter the warm-up room.
3. Buses should unload students in the school parking lot. Percussion may unload equipment at the rear stage entrance. Instrument cases must remain on buses or instrument vehicles. Do **NOT** play instruments outside of the warm-up room.
4. The contest will run on **SATELLITE** (cell phone) time. Your warm-up time begins at your designated time and **INCLUDES** both entering and exiting the room (**High School Choir Room**). The room **MUST** be vacant at the end of your warm-up time. The warm-up room will **NOT** be set to your seating arrangement, but will have chairs in a standard "horseshoe" band arrangement. You may reset as needed, but that will be part of your warm-up time.
5. High School Varsity Bands are on a 30-minute schedule, **ALL** other bands are on a 25-minute schedule.
6. On the Concert Stage (Auditorium), a bass drum, xylophone, chimes, and timpani set (4) will be provided. In the Sight Reading Room (Band Hall), a bass drum, xylophone, and timpani set will be provided. **EACH SCHOOL MUST PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INSTRUMENTS AND ALL STICKS AND MALLETS AS NEEDED.**
7. Sinton HS will be in session during the contest, so proper conduct is expected of all students at all times. Directors, it is your responsibility to provide **PROPER ADULT SUPERVISION** for your students at all times. You are guests of Sinton HS, and should be respectful of the other competitors as well as the buildings and property.
